KEY STAGE 4 (Years 11 & 12) HOMEWORK SCHEDULE 2011/2012

In the Senior School homework is particularly important as, almost without exception, they are closely related to the demands of external examinations. In some cases they may be associated with GCSE coursework, with an extended task being completed over a number of evenings, or in preparation for controlled assessments. In most instances homework will offer the opportunity to practice, apply and extend work covered in the classroom. Each Key Stage 4 pupil can be expected to spend in the order of 8-10 hours per week on such tasks.
